Who Pays Zakat?

Zakat is a **serious obligation upon every adult Muslim** of sound mind, if their wealth exceeds the minimum amount known as Nisab.

Who Receives Zakat?

The Qur'an lists the following Muslims as eligible to receive Zakat:

- The poor
- The needy
- Those administering Zakat
- Recent reverts to Islam
- Those in captivity
- Those in debt
- Those in the path of Allah
- The wayfarer

Up to 35 families* will benefit. It will be located in a communal place such as a village centre, school or masjid.


R38 000 Community Well



Giving Orphans a Future

Muhammad and Aida are orphans in Sudan whose lives have been transformed by generous donors like yourselves. They live with their three siblings, four cousins and aunt and uncle in a single house. Their uncle is a labourer who works a lot of odd jobs to provide for them all, but his meagre income barely covers the basic necessities.
