Obligatory Ramadan fasts: 'O you who have believed! Fasting has been prescribed upon you as it was prescribed on those before you in order that you become more God conscious'. (Qur'an, 2:183)

Recommended fasting of the Bright Days: 'The Messenger of Allah (saw) used to command us to fast the three days with the shining bright nights (Al-Ayyam Al-Bid), the thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth [of every lunar month]'. (Nasa'i)

Weekly Sunnah fasts on Mondays and Thursdays: 'Deeds are presented on Mondays and Thursdays [to Allah], so I would love that my deeds be presented whilst I am fasting'. (Tirmidhi)

Voluntary fasting of six days of Shawwal: 'Whoever fasts during Ramadan, then follows it with six days in Shawwal, it will be like fasting the whole year'. (Abu Dawud)

 Weekly Sunnah fasts on Mondays and Thursdays: 'Deeds are presented on Mondays and Thursdays [to Allah], so I would love that my deeds be presented whilst I am fasting'. (Tirmidhi)
 Recommended fasting on the Day of 'Arafah (9th Dhul-Hijjah): 'It is an expiation for the sins of the preceding year and the current year'. (Muslim)
 Recommended fasting on 9th and 10th of Al-Muharram: 'Fasting on the Day of 'Ashura' I anticipate that Allah will forgive (the sins of) the year before it'. (Tirmidhi)
